School Carnival KALEIDOSCOPE





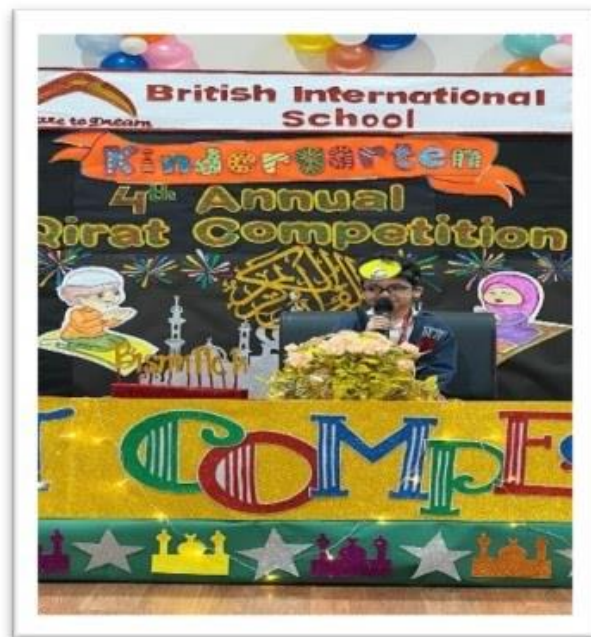

Spelling Bee 2

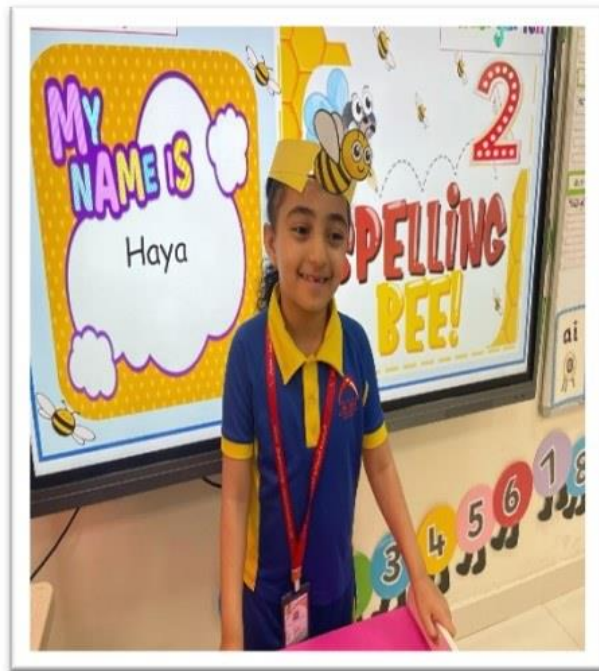






The Spelling Bee was another activity which the KG2 students were geared up with their ability to formulate and spell words using their memory power from a simple to complex sequence.



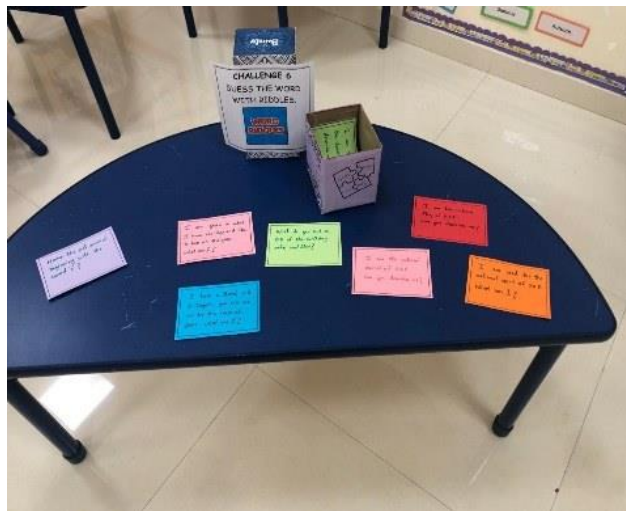




Reading Challenge





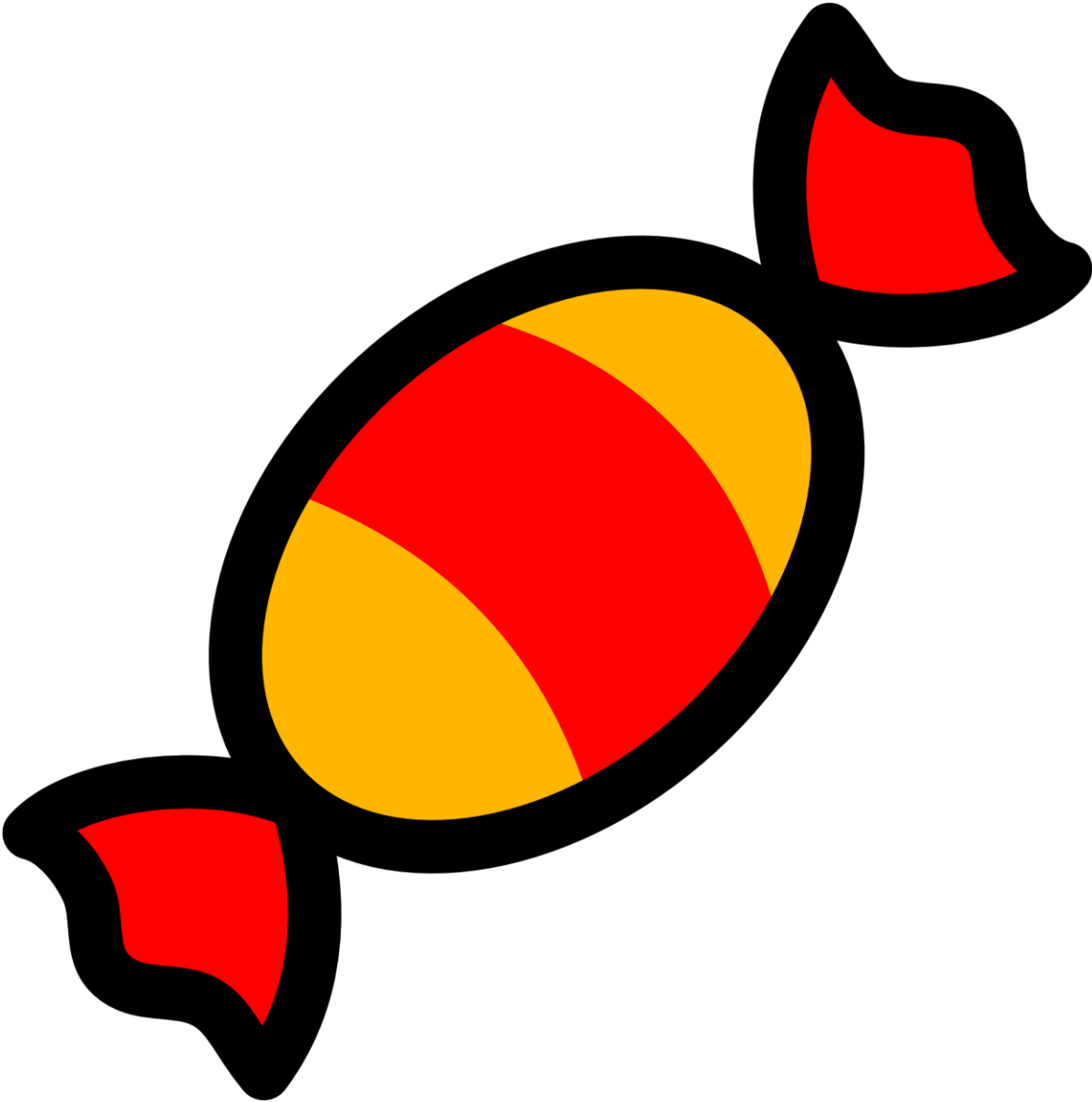
